

DO YOU NEED A **TEACHER'S DESK**




Do I need a desk? Is it serving a purpose that cannnot be replaced with something else?




Would you consider downsizing?

Teacher desks can occupy up to 15% of the instructional space. If you need more room, go back to step one.




LOSE the desk! Consider a mobile lectern.


Looking for a different solution? Try a scaled-down table on casters with a mobile file cabinet.
